Meeting called to order at 6:35 PM

- ✓ In light of new costs of waste disposal the city is facing, David Morgan would request a meeting with the new City Administrator to see if the city was interested in working towards meeting LR's 3 current goals of reduced garbage can rates, bringing recycling to Leavenworth businesses and bring recycling receptacles to downtown Leavenworth.
- ✓ LR would look into the best method to enable the schools, post office and the few downtown businesses to continue using the recycling container behind the High School.
- ✓ Look into the prospect of how to best spend LR's assets.
- ✓ Look into the steps required to terminate a non-profit no later than December 31, 2010.
